
## Method 1: Match Your Ring

Place your ring flat on each circle below. Find the circle that best matches the INSIDE edge of your ring.

## Method 2: Paper Strip Sizer

Cut along the dotted line. Wrap around your finger. Read your size where the strip overlaps.
